

Community First Pharmacy Approved to Dispense Opiate Overdose Medication (Narcan) Without a Prescription

Community First Pharmacy was the first pharmacy in Butler County approved to dispense Narcan without a prescription. Narcan, an opiate antidote, is a life saving measure that provides immediate care to an individual that is experiencing an overdose. This program is about more than keeping people from dying of an overdose, it creates a conversation with the user or those who love them to talk about treatment services and other recovery tools, to help them recover from their opiate addiction.

This is made possible through a partnership with the Butler County Mental Health and Addiction Recovery Services Board and Community Behavioral Health.

WHO CAN RECEIVE NARCAN:

- An individual who there is reason to believe is experiencing or at risk of experiencing an opioid-related overdose;
- A family member, friend, or other person in a position to assist an individual who there is reason to believe is at risk of experiencing an opioid-related overdose; or
- A peace officer as defined in section 2921.51 of the Revised Code.
