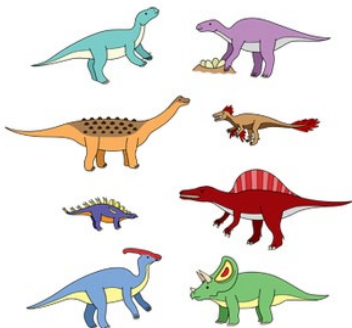
## Dramatic Play
